SCIENTIFIC, PROFESSIONAL AND ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS

1. Scientific Achievements

1.1. Thesis

In 2002 I defended my thesis in public my PhD thesis, „ Historical dimension of the law ", at the Institute of Legal Research" Academician Andrei Radulescu "of the Romanian Academy, under the guidance of Professor Ph.D. Sofia Popescu, and in that same year, I was awarded the title of Doctor of Laws.

In virtue of the order of the Minister of Education and Research no.3896 of April 24, 2003 I was awarded the PhD Diploma, Series A no.0000305 of 19 August 2003.

1.2. Publication of books and articles

After obtaining the doctorate in law, I presented or published in the country or abroad papers in the following languages: Romanian, French and Spanish. In the last 10 years I have

published 23 monographs, university courses and treated, 15 as sole author, 3 in collaboration with authors from Romania and 5 in collaboration with foreign authors. Books were published in recognized publishing houses in the country (Rosetti Publishing, Wolters Kluwer publishing, CHBeck publishing, Bibliotheca publishing) or abroad (Harmattan, Paris, Lambert Academic Publishing, Germany).

These books are in the fields of history of law, labour law, social security law, social law and European social policy. The papers published in French or Spanish can be found in university libraries in other countries, such as Law school library Castilla la Mancha University, library of Distance University of Education, Madrid, both in Spain, and the Littoral Côte d 'Opale University, France.

I have published 28 articles in journals indexed in international databases and 35 in scientific journals of recognized legal sciences. Articles published in French, Spanish or English appear in databases accessible on the Internet.

1.3. Research activities at national level

As a teacher I carry out research at the Centre d'Etudes du under International Développement et des Mouvements Economiques et sociaux - (CEDIMES) - Romania since 2006 as an associate researcher, quality in which I have participated in various events organized in different countries.

In Valachia University I have conducted research activity at the Centre for Studies in Management and Administration Research, and from 2013 I have done research activity as a researcher at the Centre for Research in Social Sciences from the Faculty of Law and Administration sciences, where I hold the function of director of the center.

I also work as a member of the project,, European Constitution and the future of Romanian Constitution ", contract no. 123/2006, executed by the ICJ of Romanian Academy, no.265/2006 and as a member of the project "Development and implementation of an integrated pilot program to increase access to higher education for people with disabilities ", ID 63951 of MECTS, in charge of training students with disabilities - educational mentor, partner 1 UVT during the period 2011- 2013.

1.4. Research, documentation activity, at international level

Since 2006, as an associate research in the LABRII (Recherche sur l'Industrie Laboratory et Innovation) situated in Dunquerque, France, I realized interdisciplinary studies presented at scientific meetings in France and other countries.

As a member of Centre d'Etudes du Développement International Economiques et des Mouvements Economiques et Sociaux (CEDIMES) -France, 2005, I carry out activities as an associate research, where I have participated in events organized in different countries on three continents.

In 2005 I received a training grant from Consorzio Tucepi, Perugia, Italy Leonardo da Vinci Programme (Project RO / 2003/91117 / EX-2005).

1.5. Participation in national and international conferences

I participated in 50 international conferences, 27 of papers delivered appeared in extenso in international conferences publications and in 21 national conferences, 10 published in full in proceedings of conferences. I attended conferences which were organized by prestigious institutions in the country (Research Institute of Law, Academician Andrei Radulescu,, "of the Romanian Academy, Valahia University, University of Pitesti, University of Craiova, University „ Dunărea de Jos" of Galați, A.I. Cuza Police Academy, Bucharest, etc.) or abroad (Université Sorbonne, Paris, Littoral Côte d'Opale University, Université de Poitiers, University of Versailles, France, Universidad Nacional de Educación a Distancia, Madrid, Spain, University of Fribourg, Switzerland, University of York, England, University of Riga, Université Mohammed V, Oujda, Morocco, University of Annaba and the University of Tlemcen, Algeria, University of Sfax, Tunisia etc.).

2. Professional Achievements

2.1. Professional prestige

Visibility and impact of scientific work I carried out can be assessed according to findings enjoyed it in the country and abroad. *Treaty of labour Law*, and other academic

papers published alone or co-authored enjoy prestige among gender publications being cited by the other manuals or papers, as well as bachelor students or doctoral dissertations.

My books and studies are cited both by prestigious authors and teachers: ITȘtefănescu Alexanderu Țiclea, Beligrădeanu Șerban, Mircea Duțu, but also by other authors who have written in the field: Ana Claudia-Moarcăș Costea, Dorneanu Valer, Radu Răzvan Popescu, Daniela Moțiu, Costel Gâlcă, Ștefan Naubauer, Ana Ștefănescu, Aurelain Gabriel Uluitu, etc.

References to my works can be found in other papers and on the websites in the country and abroad.

2.2. Positions held

Along with an intense teaching activity I pursued a professional practice as a lawyer in the Dâmbovița Bar where I have been working since 1982.

In the period 2005-2010 I worked as a lecturer at the National Institute for the Training of Lawyers in Bucharest and among the subjects taught being labour law.

Since 2004 I am chief editor of *Valahia University Law Study*, and from 2007, the year of publication, of the publication *Revue Européenne du Droit Social*, journals indexed in international databases recognized.

I am the coordinator of *Lex Universitaria* collection, published by Bibliotheca Publishing House of Targoviste, CNCS accredited, quality in which I was reviewer for numerous scientific papers in the field of law.

From 2013 I am the director of the Centre for Research in Social Science at the Valahia University, where I coordinated the majority of scientific events organized within the faculty.

3. Academic Achievements

3.1. Teaching

I have a 20 year old unbroken experience in higher legal education, only at Valahia University.

My last promotion took place during the academic year 2013/2014 by obtaining the post of professor, following the contest organized by the of Valahia University, at the subjects: *Employment, Social security*, corresponding to the decision of the Rector of Valahia University no. 153 of 3 April 2014, the position I held until today.

In the 20 years of university teaching activities I have developed and disseminated handouts and teaching materials for eight legal disciplines: 5 license - Romanian History of the State and Law; the History of Romanian public administration; Transport and insurance law; Labour law; and 3 for Social security law and Social law and social policy for master-; Community policies; European social law.

3.2. Functions and university degrees

In terms of functions chosen in the University during 2004 -2008 I was elected to the Senate of the University, and Head of Private Law Department from 2008 to 2012 I was elected to the Board appointed dean of the faculty with educational problems.

Since 2012 I am dean with problems related to scientific research and academic creation.

I am director of the Centre for Research in Social Sciences from Valahia University, from 2013, and member of the Scientific Council and the Research Council of ICSTM Valahia University.

PART II

EVOLUTION AND DEVELOPMENT PLANS OF THE PROFESSIONAL, SCIENTIFIC AND ACADEMIC CAREER

1. Develop professional career

I still want to work in the field of labour law and social security, with particular interest for European social law, which is why I intend to work closely with colleagues from universities in the country and abroad.

With this approach I want to add to my professional career the opportunity to prepare doctoral students in doctoral schools and coordinate doctoral thesis on labour law and social security.

Such activity requires the participation of as many scientific activities organized both nationally and internationally, to exchange ideas on the dynamics of the law and the way in which the national law meets European legal requirements.

2. Scientific Career Development

Research areas in which I was involved so far, such as those of labour law, social security law, and European social law will henceforth constitute a priority. As diversification branches of the law and of social developments in these areas of interest for me I can evolve towards an interdisciplinary research.

Three major trends crystallized on national, European and global level will influence the future of my research in the areas of academic consecration: a) using comparative analysis

in the scientific approach of addressing rules and institutions characteristic branches of law examined; b) harmonization of the provisions they make up; c) reconfiguring the deficient regulations, the purpose in which *ferenda* law proposals will be important.

2.1. Research Directions

2.1.1. Labour Law

Within this area I have taken most of the researches and I have published most of the books, studies and articles published. Yearly I lead papers of undergraduate students in this discipline. And in the future this will be a priority area for my research I will undertake.

In the works that will develop in the future I will emphasize whenever required the character of autonomous branch of labor law in private law.

I intend publishing in 2015 a second edition of the Treaty of Labour Law, that is, among other things, a synthesis relevant to the doctrine and jurisprudence in this area.

2.1.2 Law of social security and social policy

I wish to continue in this area of law that is a dynamic one and requires constant adaptation of legislation to social, political and economic aspects of society, not only in teaching or publicism, but also through research contracts to implement scientific approaches and reflect significant aspects of possible legislative changes or additions.

I believe that social security law will be able in the next period to answer the following trends will manifest on social protection, to establish an effective conciliation between the extension of working lives by raising the age limit for retirement and creating new jobs to be occupied mostly by children who are fit to work.

In this area, I intend to elaborate in collaboration with Gabriela Mendizábal Bermudez a bilingual work, in Romanian and Spanish representing a comparative analysis of Social security systems in Romania and Mexico.

In terms of social policy, I appreciate that progress in the development of decent work opens up new approaches; thus, a number of new challenges, Romania, as a member state of the European Union, should promote decent work as an essential component of the social model European and as an important pillar of the European construction.

I did not preferre the name, „Labour law and social security ", but I treated separately, even if I did in the same university course, the two branches of law.

Whenever I analyzed regulations that can be considered common to these branches, because social policy, I used the name of Social law.

2.1.3. European Social Law

Depth mutations occurred in Europe on employment and social protection, give me the opportunity to continuous reflections of the relationships work. Annually I direct the student to master dissertation, involving analysis of issues in this area.

European social law is a new branch of law, drawn from International labor law that achieved by specific regulations to unify the legal status of labour and social protection and its application to all categories of employees and employers in the European Union, as a branch law of its own.

In the context of the Europe 2020 objectives, I anticipate a diversified publishing and editorial activity devoted mostly to social rights of EU citizens.

I intend publishing a book in French about,, social rights in the European Union ", which will be published *Théorie et pratique collection du droit,,*" at L'Harmattan, Paris.

3. Academic Career Development

3.1. Permanent Published Works

The work undertaken has not been limited to teaching courses in nearly 20 years of constant training I published academic monographs and a Treaty on labor law, over 30, plus 87 articles and specialised studies, most of them being published in the following languages: French, English or Spanish, in recognized journals. I believe that a priority is still publishing activity.

I propose that the publications I coordinate, *Valahia University Law Study și Revue Européenne du Droit Social*, to become, as soon as possible, publications with impact factor ISI.

3.2. The participation and support of lectures at national and international conferences

I considered attending scientific meetings as a way of continuous learning, an exchange of ideas necessary in a globalized society. In this regard, in recent years I have participated in over 50 conferences and national and international scientific meetings, participation I anticipate that will be more fruitful in the future.

I will not stop to a mere participation, but I want to get involved in organizing such events, or to support the scientific committees by my presence or being in organizing committees.

3.3. Participation and support of lectures at universities abroad

So far I have lectured by Erasmus Program, at University Littroal Côte d'Ople, France, University of Castilla la Mancha and the University Juame I of Spain. Next year I intend to teach in the same context courses at the University of Naples in Italy.

As a *visiting professor* at the University I had lectures at Castiila la Mancha in Ciudad Real and La Nacional de Educación a Distancia univesidad, Madrid, Spain. I am concerned that in partnership with the Autonomous University of the State of Morelos in Mexico, to participate in the same position at the Faculty of Law of the university.

3.4. Involving in interdisciplinary research in the area of law

Since 2013 I have been the Director of the Centre for Research in Social Sciences Faculty from Valahia University, which has a total of fifteen members.

I propose that in the Centre for Research in Social Sciences, whose director I am currently other teachers or researchers from abroad to participate. I also intend to publish a book on interdisciplinary research to represent the values of the members of the center at various events (round tables, conferences, symposia) organized.

3.5. Coordination of scientific research initiated by MA / PhD students

I appreciate that all my professional experience and scientific contributions allow me to coordinate research activities of master / doctoral training in my areas.

The quality of doctoral supervisor gives me the opportunity to share teaching experience gained in 20 years of teaching career.

The support of habilitation thesis forces me to drawing new professional benchmarks, primarily for the benefit of legal sciences doctoral researchers, the main beneficiaries of my work below.

I believe that my professional maturity and the level of training allow me to contribute to the development of postgraduate training – by doctoral studies - the specialists in the legal field.
