**Tradition and innovation in the connecting
process of the Romanian administrative law to
the values system of the European Union**

Abstract

The first part of habilitation thesis was devoted to scientific achievements, professional and academic on thematic directions.

I have evoked first, the teaching activity begun in 2007 at the Department of Law of the Bucharest University of Economic Studies and that continues to the present. In the teaching process is essential the innovation and transfer of knowledge through modern methods, appropriate and adapted to the pace of social realities. My involvement in teaching was done by using modern techniques of teaching, guiding for the students' work; moderation of the student scientific sessions, as well as effort made to achieve the notebooks for seminar and courses tailored to the changing reality of public law.

I mentioned then the experience as a practitioner of the law (lawyer in the Bucharest Bar since 2005 and arbitrator at the Court of International Commercial Arbitration attached to the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Romania from 2013). The experience of practitioner of the law has helped in teaching and scientific activity by providing solutions and *de lege ferenda* proposals, which correspond as closely as possible of the social reality.

In a separate chapter I have highlighted the achieved performance for the scientific research on thematic directions. Thus, in the editorial activity I mentioned the establishment of *Juridical Tribune – Tribuna Juridica* Journal in 2011 and *Perspectives of Business Law Journal* in 2012 and the success of indexation of these journals in many databases (ProQuest, Ebsco, SSRN, CEEOL, Heinonline etc.). A significant achievement was the indexing of *Juridical Tribune - Tribuna Juridica* Journal in 2015 (at 5 years after launch) in **Thomson Reuters Web of Science - Emerging Sources Citation Index**.

Involvement in scientific activity in the field of law was achieved also by evaluating of the articles published in journals in the country and abroad, to which I hold membership in the Editorial board (*International Law Research, VSRD International Journal of Business & Management Research, Dreptul, Acta Universitatis Danubius. Juridica, Reflecții Academice*).

Another achievement in scientific research is the annual organization since 2011 of the **International conference "Perspectives of Business Law in the Third Millennium"**. In 2016, I have indexed the conference in **Thomson Reuters Web of Science**.

In 2013 I have published as editor, at *Peter Lang International Academic Publishers* the book "*Studies of Business Law. Recent Developments and Perspectives*" which is currently indexed in **Thomson Reuters Web of Science**.

My involvement in increasing the visibility of Romanian scientific research and ensuring a competitive level internationally was done by establishing the *Society of Juridical and Administrative Sciences* and the establishment within its of the *International Centre for Comparative Public Law* and *ADJURIS - International Academic Publisher*. Also in order to involve in national and international scientific activity I became an active member of the *Society of Comparative Legislation from Paris*, *the Union of Jurists of Romania*, *the Institute of Administrative Sciences "Paul Negulescu"* etc.

In a different chapter I presented my work of publication of books and articles in the field of legal sciences. I started publishing in the field of administrative law in 2005 and I have so far published two books as editor (*Contemporary Challenges in the Business Law* and *Studies of Business Law – Recent Developments and Perspectives*); 8 books as sole author of which I mention *Drept administrativ. Probleme fundamentale ale dreptului public (Administrative law. Fundamental issues of public law)*; *Legea contenciosului administrativ nr. 554/2004. Examen critic al Deciziilor Curtii Constitutionale (Administrative Contentious Law no. 554/2004. Critical examination of the Constitutional Court Decisions)*; *Contractele administrative. Reglementare, doctrină, jurisprudență (Administrative contracts. Regulatory, doctrine, jurisprudence)*; *Drept administrativ. Caiet de seminar (Administrative law. Notebook for seminar)*; 2 books as co-author [*Drept administrativ european (European Administrative Law)*, *Dreptul administrativ în Uniunea Europeană (Administrative law in the European Union)*]. I have published over 80 articles in journals of recognized authority in legal and economic field: *Juridical Tribune Juridică*, *Revista Transilvană de Științe Administrative*, *Acta Juridica Hungarica*, *Dreptul*, *Juridical Current*, *Acta Universitatis Danubius. Juridica*, *Revista de Drept Public*, *Pandectele române*, *Curierul Judiciar*, *Caiete de drept internațional*, *Tribuna Economică*, *Economie și Administrație locală* etc.

In the thesis I have grouped the works published by me so far on eight thematic directions of scientific research: administrative contracts; European Administrative Space; administrative litigation; fundamental issues of public law - books of course and seminar to disciplines of public law; public property and public services; associative structures of administrative-territorial units; public law of business; other studies in public law.

In the second part of the thesis I described my plans for evolution and development of professional, scientific and academic career.

In developing of the teaching career, I proposed to improve teaching methods and the achievement with the students of an online dictionary of administrative law. Also, after habilitation certificate, I want to contribute to skills development of scientific researcher of doctoral students in the field of administrative law.

In developing of scientific career is my intention that the two journals that we coordinate as editor (*Juridical Tribune - Tribuna Juridica* and *Perspectives of Business Law Journal*) to reach the top 100 legal journals in the world, publishing a Guide to drafting of PhD theses in the field of law, development of the international conference "Perspectives of the Business law in the Third Millennium" by making its partnership with law school of a prestigious foreign universities, creating a new conference with a theme extended to matters within the scope of administrative law and public administration, obtaining of research grants and participation as a member of research teams in international projects, publishing a monograph devoted to *European administrative law* and a *Course of administrative contracts*, initiating and developing programs of master's degree in administrative law.
